You should bring:

- We're playing, so it might get messy! Bring painting-appropriate clothing!
- Tube watercolors, or any acrylic paints you wish to bring. (You can bring either or both.) If you use a palette to mix colors, bring that as well.
- White gesso and black gesso.
- Black drawing materials of any type you can find, such as water-soluble graphite (my current favorite), vine charcoal, compressed charcoal, graphite sticks or chunks, graphite pencils, conte crayon, or even magic markers. Bring a variety that you think will allow you to make lots of different kinds of marks--dark, grey, heavy, narrow, thick, etc. You can accomplish a lot with only one or two mark-makers, but the greater variety you can afford, the greater you will be able to explore the use of line and shape.
- A variety brushes to paint, but at least one brush of 1" wide. If you don't already have a larger brush, go to the hardware or craft store and buy a *cheap* 1" or 2" brush! You can find them for under \$2.
- Paper to paint on. Bring at least 5 sheets for a day-long workshop. You may use only one or two... but there is nothing more frustrating than having time left and having no paper to work on! Bring the largest size you are comfortable painting on, but the bigger the better, up to a full sheet (22x30).
